

# SCATA/NAFEPA Scholarship Program 2026 Cover Page

#### **Purpose**

The purpose of the scholarship program is to financially support post-secondary education for qualifying high school seniors attending their first year of college. For **SCATA**, scholarships are awarded at 3<sup>rd</sup> Place (\$1000); 2<sup>nd</sup> Place (\$1500); and 1<sup>st</sup> Place (\$2000). These are non-renewable. For **NAFEPA**, there are four scholarships, each worth \$5,000, distributed over two consecutive years (\$2,500 each year). Two scholarships are for students pursuing degrees in education. The other two scholarships are awarded to applicants pursuing degrees in any field of study.

#### **Eligibility**

High school students who are on track to graduate by the conclusion of the 2025-2026 academic year are eligible to apply for the SCATA and NAFEPA scholarships. In addition, the applicant must be enrolled in a public school district or charter school (public school academy) with at least one current SCATA and NAFEPA member. (Contact the SCATA Regional Representative or the State's NAFEPA Representative who will be able to verify membership). Once the state winners are selected for the state SCATA scholarships, candidates will be nominated by the NAFEPA state affiliate organization or representative for the NAFEPA scholarships. Each state may select one candidate to nominate for the national NAFEPA scholarship program; however, states with more than 100 NAFEPA members, such as South Carolina, may nominate two candidates.

#### **Selection Criteria**

Criteria	Points
1. A personal essay of 350 - 500 words that reflects proper conventions of writing and fully	50 points
addresses the required discussion points (See Application Checklist for discussion points.)	
2. GPA, based on the applicant's Spring 2024 High School transcript.	20 points
3. School, community, service, leadership and/or work activities and experiences in which the	15 points
applicant participated during grades 9-12, including leadership positions held.	
4. Three letters of recommendation including a letter from the student's high school principal or	15 points
administrative designee, a faculty member/advisor, and a non-family member.	

#### **Scholarship Payment**

The full amount of each scholarship will be made payable to the institution of the recipient's choice for the 2025-26 academic year. It is the responsibility of each scholarship recipient to forward enrollment verification and a tuition invoice from the institution to the SCATA Secretary-Treasurer. If a candidate from SC wins the NAFEPA award, enrollment verification and a tuition invoice from the institution must be sent to the NAFEPA Representative/scholarship chairperson. Please note that the scholarship is paid directly to the institution.

#### **Application Process**

#### **Student Applicant:**

- 1. Complete the application and attach all required information. Use one-sided pages only. Separate the packets using paper clips or a folder. No staples, please.
- 2. Submit two copies of the completed application packet (one original and one copy) to your school's guidance office to forward to the district Title I Director or Federal Program Director.
- 3. The school district will select a winner for the Regional Competition.



#### **Regional Representatives:**

- 1. Convene a meeting to review and determine winners for the region. Please select a 1<sup>st</sup> Place, 2<sup>nd</sup> Place, and 3<sup>rd</sup> Place winner.
- 2. Forward the winning application packets to both of the State's NAFEPA Representatives by *January 14*, 2026 at the addresses below:
